

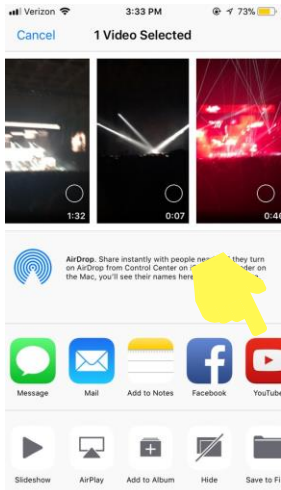
YOUTUBE 101

1) Use your smartphone and record a video.

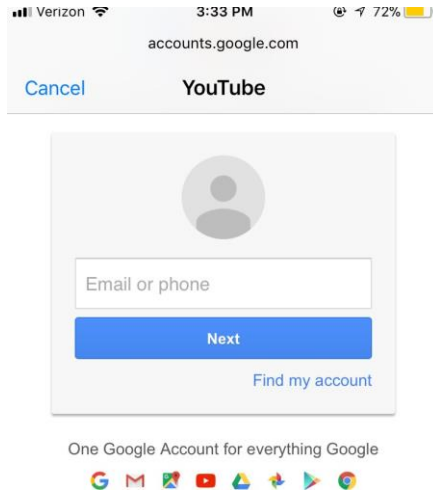
Open the camera app, switch to the video setting, and press record.

2) Upload to YouTube via smartphone.

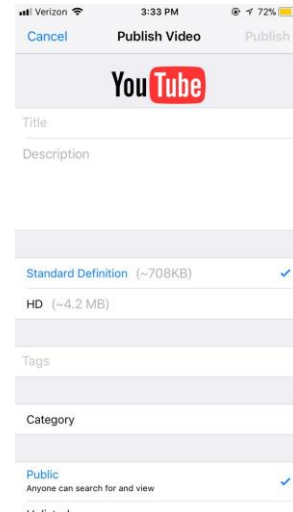
If you have an iPhone, you can upload to Youtube directly from your Camera Roll. Just go to your video, hit the blue arrow in the bottom left corner.



Next you'll see this screen. Near the bottom right is the YouTube icon, click that to upload directly to YouTube from your iPhone.



You will then be prompted to login to your Gmail/YouTube account.



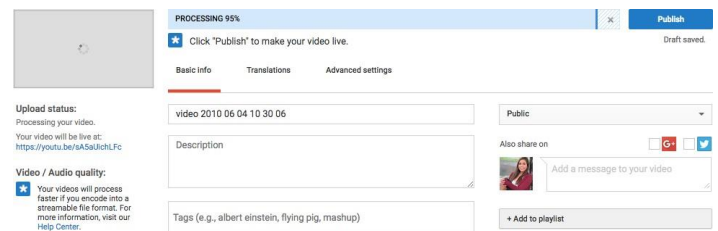
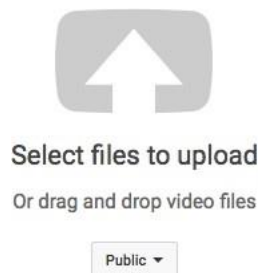
After you login, you will see this screen, Fill out the boxes accordingly, then hit upload. You're set!

2) Upload to YouTube via desktop.

Once you have recorded your video, email it to yourself. Then, get on a desktop, open the email, and save the video file to your computer. Once the file is saved to your computer, go to youtube.com. From here, look at the top right corner. Click on the camera with a + in the middle to upload your video.



Once you click this, it'll ask you to select files to upload. Click this, select your video, and the video will start uploading.



After it begins uploading, fill out these boxes and your video is ready to go!
