

1) Use your smartphone and record a video.

Open the camera app, switch to the video setting, and press record.

2) Upload to YouTube via smartphone.

If you have an iPhone, you can upload to Youtube directly from your Camera Roll. Just go to your video, hit the blue arrow in the bottom left corner.

2) Upload to YouTube via desktop.

Once you have recorded your video, email it to yourself. Then, get on a desktop, open the email, and save the video file to your computer. Once the file is saved to your computer, go to youtube.com. From here, look at the top right corner. Click on the camera with a + in the middle to upload your video.



Once you click this, it'll ask you to select files to upload. Click this, select your video, and the video will start uploading.
